

I WANT TO SEE HIS FACE

Jesus says, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God" (Matthew 5:8). To see God, we must be pure in heart. What does it mean to be pure in heart? It means to be clean of sin, but even more it means to have a single minded, undivided desire for God. When our God is supreme desire, when nothing matters to us compared to knowing the Lord, then we are pure in heart, and we will see God. Before we see him, we must want him.

If we are discouraged by how dimly we know God, let us seek him all the more urgently. And when God blesses and refreshes us with a sense of his nearness and a taste of his glory, let's not settle for that. Let's keep seeking and praying for more.
